







New E-Verify Design *February 2016*







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1.0 INTRODUCTION

This overview of the new E-Verify design introduces enhancements that improve the user experience on desktop and mobile devices. While the screen design and login address for employers and corporate administrators have changed, the E-Verify process and policies remain the same. All users must follow the guidelines in the Memorandum of Understanding for Employers and the E-Verify User Manual.

The new login URL for employers and corporate administrators is <u>https://e-verify.uscis.gov/web</u>. We recommend saving this to your browser's bookmarks or favorites.

For the purpose of this overview, the terms:

- "New E-Verify design" refers to the updated E-Verify website, at <u>https://e-verify.uscis.gov/web</u>;
- "Employer" means any person, company, or other entity that is required to complete Form I-9, Employment Eligibility Verification, including any individual with an E-Verify user account; and
- "Original website" refers to the original E-Verify website, at https://e-verify.uscis.gov/emp.

1.1 OVERVIEW



Below are highlights of the changes on the E-Verify home page:

- MENU BAR: When you log in, you will notice the left-side navigation menu now appears at the top of the screen. Select any heading to show a list of related actions. The process for creating a case is the same; for guidance, review the <u>E-Verify User Manual</u>.
- 2. ROTATING BANNER: This will introduce new features, news stories and announcements for all users.
- **3. COMPANY INFORMATION:** The company name now appears at the top of the desktop screen, so managers of multiple accounts can immediately know which account is active.
- **4. QUICK LINKS:** These links provide direct access to four commonly used E-Verify features: Verify Employee, Search Cases, View Resources, and Contact Us.
- 5. MESSAGE CENTER: This center for news and announcements replaces E-Verify News.

1.2 MOBILE DEVICES HOME PAGE



On a mobile device, the new home page automatically adjusts itself to the size of the screen.

1. MENU BAR: The left-hand navigation menu now appears at the top. Select "Menu" to show all the categories that appear at the top of the home page for desktop computers.

2.0 FORM I-9 INFORMATION SCREENS

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The screens for the employee's Form I-9 information have been reordered to follow the order on the form, making it easier to transfer the data to E-Verify.

3.0 RESOURCES AND CONTACT INFORMATION
